Record shows that after disposal of the interim relief petition, the case has been pending for evidence of the workman on merit since 30.04.2019, but both sides have not been attending thereafter for a long time for evidence on merit.

Hence, I hold that the industrial dispute is no longer in existence.

Hence, it is,

ORDERED

that the case No. 04/2012 under Section 2A(2) of The Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 is dismissed as the industrial dispute is no longer in existence.
